## Homeopathic Forms ~

Granules are the smallest and are sometimes called globules. The next sizes are pillules, globules or pellets (little tablets), and then tablets. Homeopathic pill forms are generally dispensed by units of weight that originated in early apothecaries by ancient measures of grains of wheat or other edible grains (i.e., 1 grain, 3 grain, 5 grain, etc.) Homeopathics are also dispensed in liquid form which are typically dispensed in drops for use sublingually. There are also homeopathic remedies made into ointments, creams, and lotions.

Not all, but some drug responses in the body change with the dosage. For instance, small doses of alcohol have a stimulating effect on the body, while larger doses have a depressive effect. **Note:** Blocks in energy are patterns that disrupt the flow of energy throughout the body. Other manifestations may be a combination of physical and emotional or emotional/mental indications which present as appetite suppression or unconstrained food intake, sudden intense and/or uncontrolled negative emotions such as fear, great grief or angry outbursts, unforgiveness, or “emotional” spending or gambling. **There is no chemical or surgical method for healing blocks as they occur on an energetic vibrational (quantum) level.**

In instances where this is too difficult (chickens, horses and other farm animals) provide a clean container with fresh water and add the homeopathic remedy to the water. They will have received the complete dose when the water is gone. Liquid homeopathics are more easily administered in these situations. Also, you may choose to use a plastic pip when giving the remedy orally to animals as they can fuss with potential to bite a glass pip.
