Part-way through each session we will shift gears to allow you to ask some of your pressing questions – ask anything you’d like about the school, your studies, health, your office, etc.

Is Genesis School of Natural Health Accredited?

Yes, we are accredited by the American Association of Drugless Practitioners. The AADP is recognized by both, traditional and non-traditional holistic schools and colleges world-wide as an independent accrediting board for alternative health educational institutions and programs.

Will I qualify for Board Certification?

The AADP Certification and Accreditation Board provides full board professional accreditation and certification to both institutes of higher education and professional practitioners. Students who have received their diplomas are encouraged to apply at www.aadp.

May I freely practice as an Herbalist?

Absolutely. Presently, there exists no licensure in the United States for Herbalists. They can freely practice, as long as they do not diagnose or treat or violate any laws in your state that pertain to "practicing medicine - presenting yourself as a doctor" or "nutritional counseling - presenting yourself as a dietician or nutritionist". Below is a site that tracks the states that have implemented nutritional laws.

"Currently herbalists are not licensed in any states in the United States. If there is an exclusive scope of practice nutrition licensing law (red or orange on the map) in a state, then it is illegal for herbalists to provide nutrition counseling unless they obtain a nutrition license, or fall under an explicit exemption, which is rare.

Practicing herbalists MUST review the scope of the nutrition law in their state including all exceptions and exemptions to assess whether they are legally able to use nutrition tools in their practice. Seeking legal advice may help to determine whether laws governing nutrition care would be violated by the use of nutrition tools in an herbalist practice." - <http://www.nutritionadvocacy.org/laws-state#78>

- We do not diagnose disease. We analyze and evaluate conditions, symptoms, and lifestyle habits. We do not claim to be a doctor or dietician/nutritionist. We are natural health professionals, herbalists, holistic health professionals...
- We do not treat a specific disease. We focus on healing the entire body naturally. We address or remove the root causes and practice the healing power of nature.
- We do not prescribe drugs. We depend on naturally occurring vitamins, minerals, and other nutrients built into the plant structure of whole foods and herbs and practice "do not harm".
- We maintain the highest standard of professional and personal conduct and abide by all state and local laws.
- We are willing to consult and seek the talents of other health professionals when needed. We do not practice beyond our ability and we are up to date on all information given to our clients.
- We take a holistic approach to support the whole person. We teach, guide, and encourage.

What is Traditional Naturopathy?

"Naturopathy is a philosophy which encompasses a view of life, a model for living a full life. The word naturopathy is a Latin-Greek hybrid which can be defined as 'being close to or benefiting from nature.'" — Stewart Mitchell, *Naturopathy: Understanding the Healing Power of Nature*

A Traditional Naturopath does not treat or diagnose "diseases". They do teach and encourage lifestyle changes like diet, exercise, and sleep. Traditional Naturopaths support the body's natural healing processes with natural healing approaches.

Can I practice Naturopathy anywhere after receiving my diploma from Genesis School of Natural Health?

We teach traditional naturopathy which is a natural health art recognized in all 50 states except South Carolina and Tennessee. Since traditional naturopaths do not diagnose or treat they can legally exercise their practice. It is not to be confused with naturopathic medicine that Naturopathic Physicians practice, they are licensed in about 19 states to diagnose and treat. **See www.anma.org for details on state legislations.**

The practice of Traditional Naturopathy is recognized as a common occupation at the Federal level (U.S. Congress 1928, 1929, 1930 and 30 Federal Court rulings between 1958 and 1978) and as such it is a profession protected under the 14th and 9th Amendments of the U.S. Constitution. Several states have also made this stipulation either by statute or in the Courts.

Can I use the ND title in states where naturopathic Physicians have obtained exclusive licensure?

You must check with your State. We have chosen to use TND as a designation but there are some hostile laws and people that may even frown at the similarity. Genesis gives the option of choosing TND or HHP If you cannot use the ND or TND. Other designations allowed in States where you cannot bear the ND status are: Natural Health Practitioner (NHP), Doctor of Natural Medicine (DNM), Naturopathic Practitioner (NP), Holistic Health Practitioner (HHP), Alternative Medicine Diplomate (AMD) and others.

Can I legally give individual nutritional counseling?

As of writing, 23 states require a state license for nutritional counseling, the others do not. All nutritionists can educate, give general natural health guidance and sell nutritional products. We use the designation of Natural Health Consultant to specifically avoid conflict with dietician groups in the political arena.

Interaction with clients will involve conversations about food and drink choices regardless of whether you are designated as a HHP, TND, NHC, MH, or HC. Know your state laws so your language is correct when helping clients and developing written materials like brochures. It is not what you do, it is what you say and write that can get you in trouble.

Will my transcripts be accepted at other schools for credit?

It totally depends on the school. Genesis does not have government accreditation (this is the same for most natural health online programs including Trinity, New Eden, and many more). Professional accreditation is recognition by professionals which is not the same as a government accredited college or university.

Licensure

A few states require a license to work in specific areas of the natural health field. Genesis School of Natural Health does not meet the educational requirement of any state where a license is required. It is the student's responsibility to find out the individual requirements of your state so you are in compliance with their laws.

Our online distance learning programs lead to non-traditional diplomas and designations. Genesis School of Natural Health does not have, nor do we plan to seek accreditation through the U.S. Department of Education.

Genesis School of Natural Health has avoided any known language that may become an issue as the medical profession and drug companies try to limit our access to natural health consultants and natural products.

We do not offer a Doctor of Naturopathy diploma or degree. It is called Traditional Doctor of Naturopathy. You may choose the recognition OF Holistic Health Professional for the same program. If you choose the TND program and later find out that this was not a wise decision we will give you a new diploma stating you are a HHP (a fee for a new transcript and new diploma will apply but as of now it would only be \$40).

We say Holistic Health Professional instead of Holistic Health Practitioner to avoid the word "practitioner" which may be viewed as a medical designation in the future. The definition of practitioner: "a person actively engaged in an art, discipline, or profession, especially medicine"

We do not offer "degrees". The name implies that the credits can transfer to government accredited schools and I find that misleading. We offer professional diplomas to recognize and verify your many hours of study and completion of our program.

Prerequisites

We require the minimum of a high school diploma or GED to enroll in any program at Genesis. If a student is from outside the U.S. we will need a description of your educational background. Students are NOT required to have a college degree. Genesis School of Natural Health has a nondiscriminatory policy. We do not discriminate period! We exist to teach and train all those interested in the field of natural health.

Tests, Projects, and Study Groups

Tests are open book and primarily fill-in-the blank, multiple choice, and true/false. The purpose of testing is for emphasizing information and ensuring that each student has read the required materials. Projects are graded as a pass or fail. If a project is not adequate the student will be given additional instructions before resubmitting the project. There are currently three online Study Group classes led by Sharlene Peterson. They are offered every other month. Sharlene Peterson will also be leading a quarterly online class on advanced or desired subjects. Attendance is optional but encouraged.

Distance Education Requirements

1. You should have basic computer skills - you will need to know how to use email, attach files, access the Internet, download documents, and how to utilize word processing.
2. Students should have a desktop or laptop computer in their own home.
3. Students should have a Broadband Internet connection such as Cable or DSL.
4. A personal email address is required - this must not be a shared email with a spouse or other family members. If your email contact changes you must notify us immediately - send us an email using your new address with the Subject stating "NEW EMAIL ADDRESS".
5. Students must download the free software program Adobe Reader that is used for reading the tests that are in PDF format.

Application, Registration and Fees

The first step to enrolling at Genesis School of Natural Health is to submit the online student application form. Our Student Administrator will contact you to answer any questions. Unless there are serious reservations about your ability to complete the courses, you will be registered immediately. There is a \$250 non-refundable application fee which is included in the tuition pricing. The fee per credit hour is \$50.00 for formal studies that include books/manuals.

After registration you will immediately receive a Welcome Letter via email with your Student ID #, passwords, and all the information you will need to get started. Darlene Jorgens is our student advisor and can help you with any questions you may have. We do require a completed Student Profile and a small photograph via email for each student's file. The information in the Student Profile and the picture are for office use only - we will not publish or share student information with anyone.

All textbooks and CD/DVD purchases are the responsibility of the student and are available at many online bookstores. We do provide several downloadable manuals that are included in the tuition. An installment plan for all programs is available. Credit cards, personal checks, and money orders are accepted for tuition payment and must be in U.S. Dollars. Genesis does not participate in Federal or State financial aid programs.

Refund Policy

Students who withdraw from their program of study within the first 30 days will receive a full refund on the tuition paid for their program, minus the \$250.00 nonrefundable application fee and the fee for any completed courses. If you have given Genesis School of Natural Health authorization to process your credit card we will continue to do so until the full tuition is paid unless you formally withdraw from your program within the first 30 days. Stopping payments or course work is not considered an official withdrawal from the school. You must contact our office to withdraw from any program or class.

Transfer of Credits

Transfer of credits/classes from another school is allowed but it will be done on an individual basis. There are no fees for the transfer of classes - we are pleased that you have chosen to continue your education at our school.

Accreditation

We are accredited by the American Association of Drugless Practitioners. The AADP Certification and Accreditation Board provides full board professional accreditation and certification to both institutes of higher education and professional practitioners. Students who have received their diplomas are encouraged to apply at www.aadp.org.

Accreditation is voluntary and does not carry any influence for those who receive diplomas. Please read the following articles on our website: "What is Accreditation?" and "Boards and Certification"

Time Limit for the Programs

There is no set time in which the student must complete any individual phase of learning; however, the student must complete the entire program within the following guidelines. If a student has had to take time off because of family or job situations we will extend the time.

- A 3-year time limit applies to the single-diploma programs: Master Herbalist, Clinical Master Herbalist, Natural Health Consultant, Holistic Health Professional and Doctor of Traditional Naturopathy
- A 4-year time limit applies to Double-Diploma and Triple-Diploma programs.

Extension or Leave of Absence

If the student is unable to complete a program within the time limit they may request an Extension or a Leave of Absence (emergency or life changing events) by written request (mail or email only). The Extension or Leave of Absence request will be reviewed on an individual basis and the student will be notified of the decision made. All Extensions and Leave of Absences have a time limit of one year.

Grading Scale

90-100% (A); 80-89% (B); 75-79% (C)

If a student receives a grade below 75% arrangements will be made through the Student Administrator to determine if full retesting is required or if there was an area within the testing that needs clarification and a partial retest is sufficient. We want to see you succeed both in the classroom and professionally in the future.

Graduation Requirements, Diplomas, and Transcripts

A student will be eligible for graduation and receive their diploma(s) when the following conditions are fulfilled:

1. Student has completed all required courses and credit hours
2. Student has received a 75% or better in all classes; and
3. Student has met all financial obligations.
